

# CLIENT BILL OF RIGHTS

Education and Training: I received my initial education and training with Hypnosis with Omni Hypnosis Center of Washington, D.C. and also with ICBCH(International Certification Board of Clinical Hypnotherapy. I continue to ongoing training annually to keep current on new methods and updates to maintain highest level possible for best results for my clients. I am certified by the National Guild of Hypnotists, which is the oldest and largest Hypnosis organization in the world—and this organization is most widely recognized for the professional practice of Hypnosis.

**Notice: The state of Maryland has not adopted educational and training standards for the practice of Hypnosis. The statement of credentials is for informational purposes only.** Hypnotism/Hypnosis is a self-regulating profession and its practitioners are not licensed by state governments.
